# CANADIAN 5 PIN BOWLERS' ASSOCIATION NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS DRESS CODE POLICY

# **Purpose**

The Canadian 5 Pin Bowlers' Association strives to be a professional organization in all aspects from private operations to public observations.

## Policy:

Each bowler, coach and manager must be dressed uniformly as per their approved provincial colours.

### 1.0 Shirts/Blouses

- Bowling shirts or blouses must have sleeves, a collar and be of the same design in registered Provincial Association colours with appropriate province and bowler identification.
- A ladies style shirt is permissible and can be with or without buttons but must have a finished neckline.
- Participants may have an unlimited amount and unlimited sizing of sponsorship logos and/or identification anywhere on their team's shirts while maintaining a clear view of participants association and name. Sponsors may vary between individuals. Sponsors my not be in conflict with sponsors of the C5PBA. Sponsorship from tobacco companies or sponsors considered detrimental to the spirit of sport will not be allowed.

# 2.0 Bottom Apparel

- Individuals on a team must wear black bottoms, or registered provincial colours, but each may wear a different length/style bottom.
- Dress pants, skirts, skorts, dress shorts or capris shall have a straight hemmed bottom (no denim of any colour, stirrups, see-through or sheer leggings, harem, cargo, ruggers or sweat pants of any kind. No draw strings or no elastic at the hem of any kind).
- The dress pants, skirts, skorts, capris or dress shorts shall not be faded, torn, ripped, contain studs, buttons or pockets on the legs.
- The skirts, skorts or dress shorts may not be shorter than just below the fingertips when placing your arms at your side.
- When patterned dress pants, skirts, skorts, dress shorts or capris are chosen (ie. Loudmouth) as part
  of a provincial uniform, the colours in the pattern must be in the provincial colours and must be preapproved by the C5PBA Executive at the previous C5PBA meeting.

#### 3.0 Other

- No hats or caps or other headgear are allowed unless worn for religious or medical reasons.
- Hairbands are allowed if in the provincial colours or black.
- Knee or thigh length socks (ie. compression socks) are allowed.
- Items found derogatory or offensive will not be allowed.

## 4.0 Penalty

• Failure to adhere to the dress code rule will result in a \$100 penalty being assessed, for each uniform infraction, to the province. The competitor will be given a reasonable amount of time prior to being fined to get the appropriate attire.

# **5.0 Procedure for Change**

- Requests for changes or alternate options which differ from this policy will only be considered at a general meeting of the C5PBA.
- Changes outside of the above time will not be considered and will therefore be denied.
