



C5PBA Hall of Fame Policy

Classification of Member's

- Founding Fathers
- Players (bowlers)
- Builders
- Coaches
- Dual Inductee

Eligibility for selection

- Any person who is or has been distinguished as a player, a builder or a coach may be honoured as a member of the C5PBA Hall of Fame.
- Players, coaches and builders may be active or inactive at their time of selection.
- Members of the C5PBA Board of Directors, staff or selection committee are eligible for selection.

Appointment of Selection Committee

- The C5PBA Board of Directors shall appoint a selection committee consisting of 6 current member's, who are knowledgeable in the history and traditions and whose prestige, judgment, and integrity are most to likely ensure the fair and impartial assessment of the qualifications of the candidates.
- In the appointment of the committee, consideration will be given to ensure all provinces are represented where possible.
- The Chair will be the 1st Vice President of the C5PBA and will have a vote in the selection process.
- Appointments to fill vacancies will be made by the C5PBA Executive.

Basis of Selection

Player

- Nominees shall have a minimum of five (5) years participation as an athlete at the National level;
- Nominees shall have a minimum of ten (10) years playing experience;
- Nominees shall have exhibited the highest standards of teamwork, sportsmanship and fair play and displayed leadership qualities;

- The Board shall have the right to determine eligibility for those individuals who made a significant contribution to 5 pin bowling in Canada and may not meet the requirements above, upon the recommendation of the Committee; and
- The Staff of C5PBA shall be eligible.

Builder

- Nominees shall have a minimum of ten (10) years as a volunteer in the sport of 5 pin bowling;
- Nominees shall have made an outstanding contribution to 5 pin bowling in Canada at the national level in one or more of the following categories:
 - i. Growth and development;
 - ii. Promotion;
 - iii. Coaching and/or officiating; or
 - iv. Administration.
- Nominees shall be or have been involved in athlete recruitment, coaching, officiating, fundraising, sponsorship, hosting special events, association management and/or development of new programs and initiatives;
- The Board shall have the right to determine eligibility for those individuals who made a significant contribution to 5 pin bowling in Canada and may not meet the requirements above, upon the recommendation of the Committee;
- The Staff of the C5PBA shall be eligible.

Coaches

- Nominees shall have a minimum five (5) years coaching experience at the National level
- Nominees shall have a minimum of ten (10) years' experience as a 5 pin bowling coach;
- Nominees shall have displayed excellent communication with, and respect for, other coaches, officials, athletes and parents;
- The Board shall have the right to determine eligibility for those individuals who made a significant contribution to 5 pin bowling in Canada and may not meet the requirements above, upon the recommendation of the Committee; and
- The Staff of the C5PBA shall be eligible.

Dual Inductee

- Any person who has been selected in a category can be nominated in another category. This is rare but we do have a number of people who fit in more than one category.

Nomination Process

- Each province / territory through its provincial body, may make one nomination for each category and each selection must be signed by the provincial / territorial president.

- Each member of the C5PBA Executive and Executive Director may make one nomination for each category.
- All nominations shall be made in writing on the applicable Hall of Fame application form. All nominations must be submitted to the C5PBA office 60 days prior to the AGM.
- Forty-five days prior to the AGM each member of the selection committee will receive a copy of all nominations and supportive documentation. The committee will meet prior to the AGM.
- All nominations must be endorsed by two Provincial/Territorial President or C5PBA Executive members or C5PBA Executive Director.
- Nominations will stay active for 3 years at which time they can be re-submitted. The office will ensure all nominations will stay on file for 3 years.

Method of Election

- Each year 4 bowlers, 2 builders and 1 coach may be inducted into the C5PBA Hall of Fame.
- Nominees will be inducted as part of the closing Ceremonies at any C5PBA National Championship where possible.
